## Language


The **subject** names the person or thing the sentence is about.

The **predicate** tells what the subject is or does.

A compound subject is two or more subjects with the same predicate. (Usually joined by and or or.)

A compound predicate is two or more predicates with the same subject. (Usually joined by and, but, or or.)
