Language

A **linking verb** link, or connects, the subject of a sentence to a noun or adjective that describes or renames the subject.

Ex. The red jewel **is** valuable.

A linking verb does not show action.

Linking verbs are most often forms of **be (am, is, are, was, were)**. Other linking verbs include **look, seem, become, feel, grow, smell, and taste**.

Ex. The jewels **seem** small.
