A verb has three basic tenses: present, past, and future.

To make the present progressive form, use am, are, or is and the -ing form of a main verb.

Ex. I am jogging around the lake.

To make the past progressive form, use was or were and the -ing form of a main verb.

Ex. She was driving home.

To make the future progressive form, use will be:

Ex. She will be driving home.
