A verb has three basic tenses: present, past, and future.

To make the present progressive form, use \underline{am} , \underline{are} , or \underline{is} and the $\underline{-ing}$ form of a main verb.

Ex. I am jogging around the lake.

To make the past progressive form, use <u>was</u> or <u>were</u> and the -ing form of a main verb.

Ex. She was driving home.

To make the future progressive form, use will be:

Ex. She will be driving home.
