Language

- A **common** noun names any person, place, or thing. (boy, country)
- A **proper** noun names a specific person, place, or thing. (Tom, France)
- Proper nouns always begin with **capital letters**.
Capitalize the names of days of the week, months, and holidays. (Monday, September, New Year's Day)
Capitalize important words in the titles of magazines, books, essays, and historical documents. (*Frindle*)
Capitalize the names of languages, races, nationalities, and historical events. (Spanish, English, British)
Capitalize product names. (Nike)
Capitalize geographical names. (Atlantic Ocean)

AL History

- **fossil** - the preserved remains of a plant or animal from long ago
- **paleontologist** - a scientist who studies fossils
- **artifact** - an object that was made and used by people long ago
- **archaeologist** - a scientist who studies the lives and cultures of people from the past
- **adapt** - to change
