Language

Pronoun -Verb Agreement

A subject pronoun and a present tense verb must **agree** in number.

When using the subject pronouns **he**, **she**, and **it**, add **-s** or **-es** to most verbs.

When using the subject pronouns **I**, **we**, **you**, and **they**, **DO NOT** add **-s** or **-es** to the verb.

Use subject pronouns with the present tense forms of have:

Have - I have, you have, he/she/it has, we have, they have

Use subject pronouns with the present tense forms of be:

Be - I am, you are, he/she/it is, we are, they are
