## Language

A pronoun is a word that takes the place of one or two nouns.

A personal pronoun refers to a person or thing.

Ex. I, he she, it, you

A <u>relative pronoun</u> is used at the beginning of a dependent clause. Ex. that, which, whom, and whose An <u>indefinite pronoun</u> does not name a specific person or thing. Ex. someone

The word a noun refers to is called its <u>antecedent</u>. Ex. Lily passed the test because she studied for it.
