Irregular verbs do not follow this rule. **Irregular verbs change** to other words to show past tense.

Irregular verbs have a special form when they are used with *has*, *have*, or *had*.

Present Tense	Past Tense	Past with has, have, or had
choose	chose	chosen
get	got	gotten
