Language

Irregular nouns are made plural by changing vowels, changing the word, or adding a different ending:

- More than one man = men
- More than one person = people
- More than one mouse = mice
- More than one child = children
- More than one foot = feet
- More than one goose = geese
- More than one tooth = teeth

Some irregular plural nouns have the same spelling as their singular form such as scissors, pants, bison, deer, and sheep.
